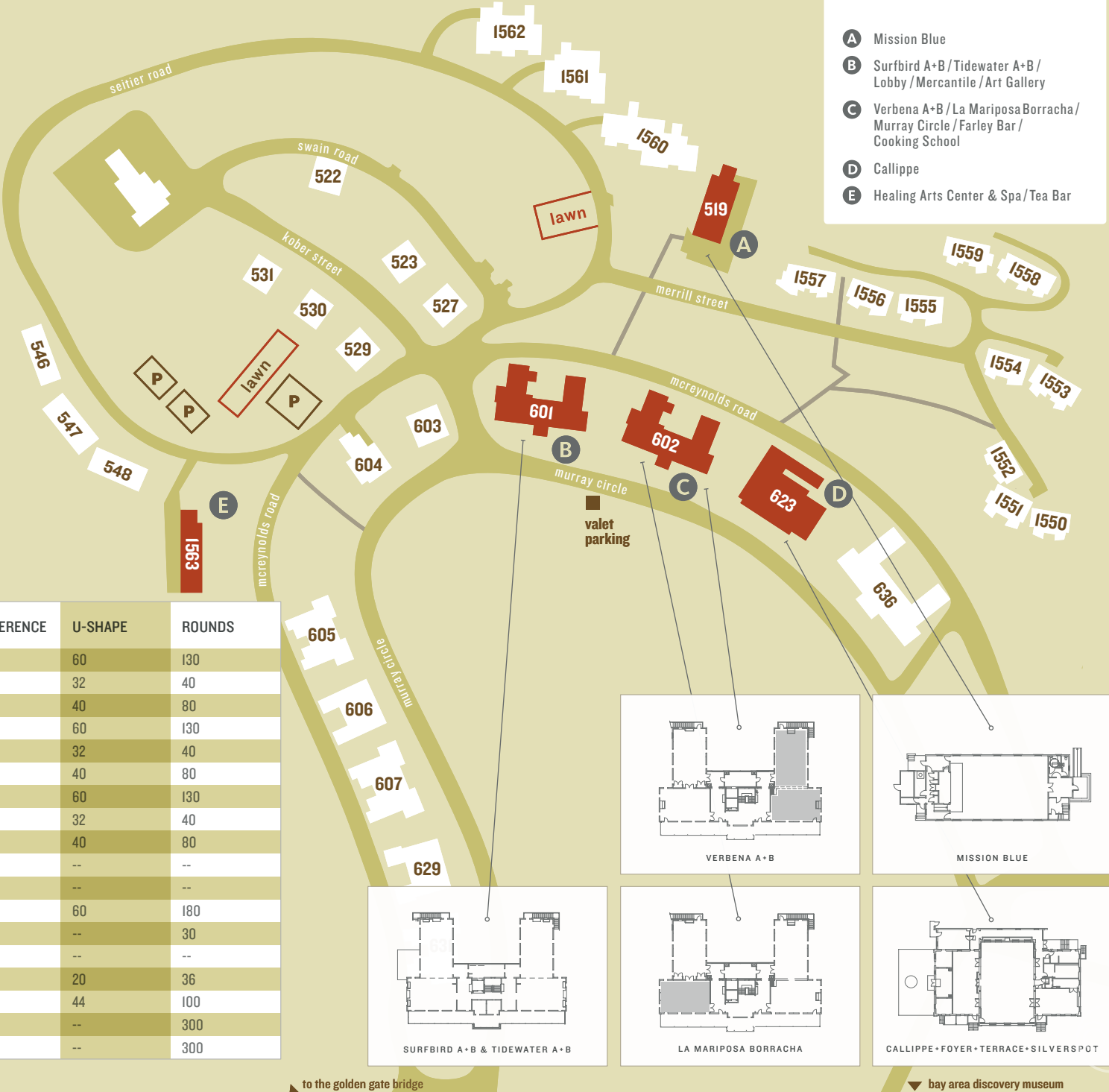

# MEETING SPACES

A place to break with convention, eco-friendly Cavallo Point provides an inspired backdrop for business meetings, corporate retreats and special events for groups of 10 to 300.

Indoors, the lodge offers 14,000 square feet of adaptable meeting space with 11 function rooms, including a dedicated boardroom, in four primary venues. Unique and distinctive, these facilities provide ample rooms for food & beverage functions, breakouts and pre-event space – with state-of-the-art technology. Each comfortable space features windows that open to fresh bay breezes and breathtaking views of the bridge, bay or hillside. Outdoors, 12,500 square feet of spectacular grounds provide unparalleled views of the bridge and bay.

Enhancing the menus are choices from our stellar wine collection, one of California's largest. Artfully assembled, the wine list features over 2,000 selections.







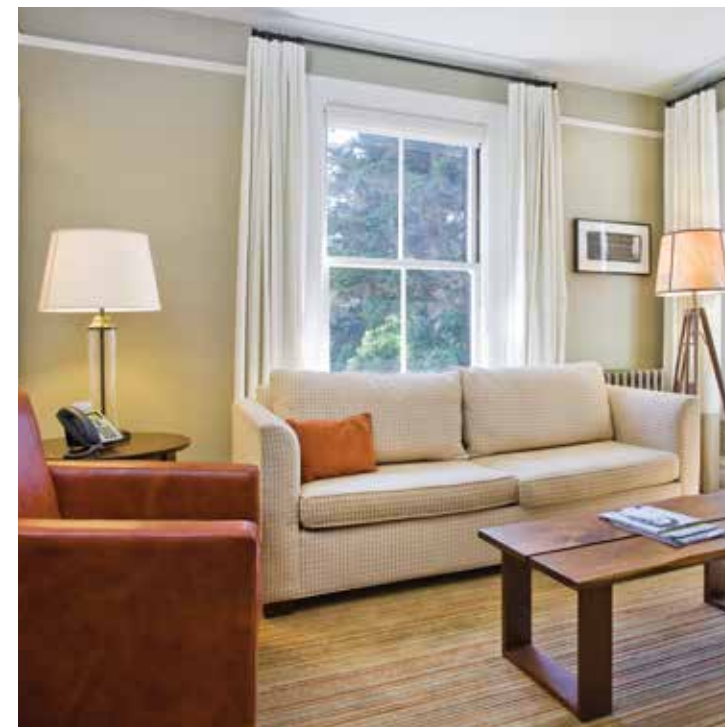




## natural comfort **LODGING**

Cavallo Point is located at Fort Baker, a former U.S. Army base that has been refashioned as a green and eco-friendly lodge. Renovated to the highest standards of preservation and sustainability, the historic buildings have been beautifully restored, giving the lodge a clean, elegant look that respects the breathtaking natural views all around.

The lodge features 142 diverse guest rooms and suites, including 68 historic lodgings and 74 contemporary accommodations. Gracious décor, organic cotton sheets, plush bedding and fine amenities offer understated elegance without excess. Inviting rooms and suites provide an evening respite from a day of problem-solving. In many guest rooms, abundant windows welcome breezes, light and stunning views of the bay, Golden Gate Bridge or Marin Headlands.

## natural & green **ENVIRONMENTAL INITIATIVES**

Cavallo Point was built to the highest standards of historic preservation, sustainability and stewardship. Since the project's inception, environmental initiatives have been a priority.

Use of green building materials includes products that are regionally sourced, with a high content of recycled materials, or made from rapidly renewable resources. In historic buildings, reclaimed materials retain connections to the past, including crown molding, pressed tin ceilings, original hardwood floors, bedroom fireplaces and inviting porches. To beautify the landscape, the property's 'historic core' features native plants and seeds from the Fort Baker watershed. To enhance visitor awareness of our environment, meeting rooms are named after local rare, threatened and endangered species, such as the Mission Blue butterfly.

In recognition of its green achievements, Cavallo Point has received numerous awards for historic restoration, sustainability and environmental design. The project earned LEED Gold certification. Cavallo Point is the first national park lodge and the first hotel on the National Register of Historic Places to gain LEED certification.

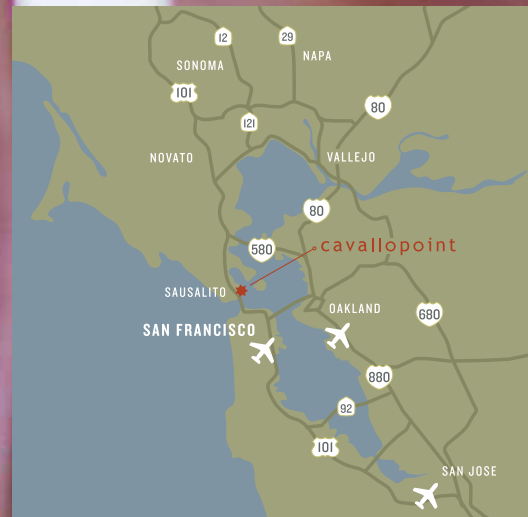
